Tribute to Philip Wamboldt, Founder of Petite Riviere Vineyards & NS Wine Industry Pioneer

Founded by Philip Wamboldt and his wife Carol in the 1990's, Petite Riviere Vineyards was developed in the South of France "Old World" style, where Philip informally studied wine growing. The first vines were planted in 1994, and the grapes were originally sold to other wineries. By 2002, the Wamboldts had begun construction on the existing French-styled winery building and harvested the first grapes for their own wine production. In the following year, Philip produced his first Canadian Gold Medal winning red wine, "Philips Reserve 2002." The Winery was opened to the public in 2004.

In 2005, Carole was sadly left on her own when Philip was lost in a tragic car accident. Carol continued working the vineyard and running the winery for the next four years. There is nothing easy about the wine industry, which certainly says a lot about Carol's courage and stewardship. Philip was truly a pioneer of the wine industry in Nova Scotia, in fact, he wrote the book on grape growing in 2002; "Nova Scotia Grape Growing" with Dr. Bruce Wright and Dr. Chris Naugler.
